Please note:

Thursday, May 22nd is the last regular school day for seniors. This will be a minimum day, and dismissal will be at 11:46 A.M. We also ask that when presenters are speaking, they are given your respect and attention. We are looking forward to sharing this accomplishment with all of our graduates and their families.

SUBJECT: Senior Letter and Activity Schedule

I am sure the excitement is growing as graduation nears and you prepare for this occasion. The following information is very important. **READ IT CAREFULLY WITH YOUR SENIOR DAUGHTER OR SON.** (Una copia está disponible en la oficina de Hemet High. Por favor llamé a Keri para una copia en español.) **WE WILL ADHERE STRICTLY TO ALL PROCEDURES AND POLICIES; SO PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU AND YOUR SENIOR UNDERSTAND THE INFORMATION COMPLETELY. WE WILL NOT MAKE ANY EXCEPTIONS!**

EVERYONE MUST HAVE A GRADUATION TICKET TO BE ADMITTED INTO THE RAMONA BOWL! The Graduation Ceremony starts at 6:00 PM. NO SAVING OF SEATS ALLOWED! The Ramona Bowl does not allow seats to be saved and our security will ask individuals to make room for the crowd at graduation.

We will use a ticket system for families and friends of graduates. Four (4) tickets will be given to each senior on Wednesday, April 23, 2014, at the Senior Dessert. Each <u>student or parent</u> will have their announcements mailed to them, and graduation tickets are available at the Senior Dessert. An ID will be required for individuals picking up graduation tickets at Senior Dessert. If graduation supplies were ordered and paid for by February 28th, then two additional tickets will be given to those seniors having met this deadline. Starting on Thursday, April 24th, each senior will be allowed to purchase two additional tickets in the ASB Office at lunch and after school for a nominal fee of \$5.00 each (the charge is needed to off-set the cost of graduation). Seniors will be allowed to purchase tickets until Wednesday, May 14th and then any tickets still available will be sold on a first come, first served basis on Thursday, May 15th in the ASB Office at lunch and after school. We recommend enclosing tickets with announcements only for those who <u>you are certain</u> will attend the ceremony. If unable to attend the Senior Dessert, then tickets may be picked up in the ASB Office starting on Thursday, April 24th at lunch or after school <u>ONLY</u>. A "FREE" shuttle bus service from the Hemet High School Stadium, and Community Christian Church will be offered to the Ramona Bowl starting at 4:00 PM

Our graduation ceremony is designed to be a <u>dignified occasion</u>. Please dress appropriately. The following procedures and rules have been established to afford participating seniors, parents, family and friends the respect and attention they each deserve. Participation in graduation is a <u>PRIVILEGE</u>. The school reserves the right to take necessary steps to make sure this is an appropriate activity in keeping with the Education Code and Governing Board policy.

General Guidelines:

1. All school rules will be enforced at all activities. Any senior involved in any disruptive celebration activities at Hemet High School <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed to walk for Graduation or any senior activity.

2. If a senior cannot attend a mandatory practice or ceremony, a written request from the parent must be submitted to Dr. Shaw <u>no later</u> than Tuesday, May 20, 2014. Notification of approval or disapproval will be made in writing by Thursday, May 22, 2014.

- 3. STUDENTS WITH UNEXCUSED ABSENCES FOR ANY MANDATORY PRACTICE OR REQUIRED CEREMONY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CEREMONIES, INCLUDING GRADUATION.
- 4. Only seniors meeting the minimum academic and citizenship qualifications of the HUSD and the State Department of Education for graduation (including the minimum grade point average of 2.0) will be permitted to participate in the Senior Awards Program and Commencement. (If you have any concerns about your student meeting the requirements, please call 765-5150.)
- 5. Seniors must clear all outstanding charges for textbooks, and library items, athletic equipment not returned, or money owed to clubs or school organizations. Cap and gown will not be issued until all charges are paid in full. CASH ONLY will be accepted after Friday, April 18, 2014. CASH ONLY!! Hemet High School will accept payment in CASH ONLY after April 18, 2014! All fines and charges must be paid no later than 11:46 AM, Thursday, May 22, 2014!
- 6. College Enrollment Credit If college credit is needed for high school graduation, a College Transcript or "work in progress" form in a sealed envelope with the college seal must be given to your counselor. Students using college credit for graduation must request that a transcript be sent to the high school by the records office of their college before a Hemet High School Diploma will be released. YOU MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE CAP AND GOWN CEREMONY ONCE YOU HAVE SUBMITTED THIS FORM BUT YOUR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA WILL NOT BE AWARDED UNTIL OFFICIAL NOTIFICATION OF COMPLETION IS RECEIVED FROM THE COLLEGE. Students using college credit for graduation must request that a transcript be sent to the high school by the records office of their college before a Hemet High School Diploma will be released.
- 7. Adult Education Credit All adult education coursework/hours/finals must be completed by THURSDAY, May 15, 2014, to ensure that credits are posted to your official transcript. YOU MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE CAP AND GOWN CEREMONY IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.
- 8. <u>BYU HIGH SCHOOL CREDIT</u> All course work is due to BYU by Friday, April 18, 2014. Exams must be requested, taken and returned to BYU by Friday, May 2, 2014, to ensure that credits are posted to your official transcript. YOU <u>MAY NOT</u> PARTICIPATE IN THE CAP AND GOWN CEREMONY IF YOU HAVE NOT COMPLETED ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.
- 9. <u>Thursday, May 22, 2014 will be the last regular school day for seniors and is a minimum day.</u> It is mandatory for students to complete a checkout form for every class on this day and clear all fines and charges by 11:46 AM on Thursday, May 22, 2014.

Seniors report to Cast House by 5:00 PM. Those seniors riding the bus to Graduation from the Hemet High School Stadium will receive a "FREE" Breakfast on Friday, May 30th at the stadium. Guys should wear dark full-length pants and a light, neutral colored shirt with a collar. Shoes should be dark and comfortable for walking, with good traction. Shorts, brightly colored tennis shoes, sandals and flip-flops ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. Girls should wear skirts, dresses, or dress pants. Dress shoes should be reasonably flat and comfortable for walking. Sandals, flip-flops, and high heels are unacceptable, if not hazardous. Students will be searched to prevent noisemakers, beach balls, silly string, etc. from disrupting the ceremonies.

<u>PARENTS</u> - This is a dress-up affair. Please dress appropriately. We have made arrangements with Chappell Studio for a professional photographer to record the moment each student is awarded his/her diploma. The full-color proofs of these photos will be mailed at no charge to your home approximately one week after graduation. Enlargements will be available to you at a reasonable price. This service will enable all students to have a photograph of their graduation. We feel that you will be satisfied with the high quality of the resulting photograph.

Families are expected to remain in their seats, enjoy the ceremony, and limit picture taking to before and after the presentation of diplomas. Please observe the rule of <u>no</u> <u>noisemakers</u> during the ceremony. Allow everyone in the Bowl the opportunity to hear the whole ceremony without interference. <u>Graduates or members of the audience who misbehave will be escorted out of the ceremony.</u>

**FRIDAY May 30, 2014 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM! **Mandatory	Caps and Gowns must be turned in at the Hemet High School Stadium on Friday, May 30 th from 9:00 -11:30 AM. (Keep tassels and stoles only.) Diplomas will be issued when you turn in your cap and gown. (If you need College credit for graduation, your diploma will be held in the counseling office until we receive a final transcript.) A Breakfast will be given to "ALL" Seniors that rode the bus to Graduation – Cost is \$8.00 to everyone else.
ALCOHOL AND DRUGS	The State law is very specific regarding alcohol and drugs. Any senior with alcohol on his or her breath or under the influence of drugs will be removed from the line and will not be allowed to participate in any senior activity. (This applies to practices as well as the ceremonies. If not "walking" due to alcohol/drugs, the student will not be allowed to attend "Grad-Night".) Members of the audience will also be turned away if they appear to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
BEHAVIOR	All school rules will be enforced at all activities. Any senior involved in any disruptive celebration activities at Hemet High School WILL NOT be allowed to walk for Graduation or any senior activity. Any behavior that is not dignified and courteous will result in removal from the event and all of the remaining senior events. Students found in possession of prohibited items (noisemakers, beach balls, silly string, etc.) before or during the ceremony may be removed from Graduation and subsequent activities.
