All current work permits will expire on June 11th. If you will be working over the summer, **you MUST apply for a new work permit.**

1. Print out the blank [Work Permit Application](#) and take it to your employer (you do need a job to apply for a work permit).
2. Scan (preferred) or send a picture of your completed work permit application to jdaniels@hemetUSD.org (Please make sure all sections - Minor information, Parent information, and Employer information - are completed to avoid delays in processing your permit application)
3. Please allow a minimum of 24 hours for your work permit application to be processed. The actual work permit will be emailed to you once it has been approved (usually within 24-48 hours)

All employed students under the age of 18 MUST have a current work permit on file.

***You must have and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and maintain at least a 90% attendance rate to be eligible for a work permit.**

Both the female and male teams put on an amazing show as the girls team won 24-0 lead by sophomore star **Andie Albers** who pinned her opponent in the first period of the match. **The female bulldogs team has been asked to sacrifice in numerous matches for the program by competing against both female and male athletes. Our lady bulldogs never flinched in the face of adversity and finished the season with a record of 4 wins and 3 loses.** This is certainly the response the coaches of the team were searching for as the season will be one to remembered for the ages.

The **males bulldogs** had the most exciting match of the season and were part of a situation that the coaching staff has never experienced. The male bulldogs team lead by, junior captain, **Dakota Rhodes** finished the dual with a 30 to 30 victory.
