All current work permits will expire on June 11th. If you will be working over the summer, you MUST apply for a new work permit.

- 1. Print out the blank <u>Work Permit Application</u> and take it to your employer (you <u>DO</u> need a job to apply for a work permit).
- 2. Scan (preferred) or send a picture of your completed work permit application to jdaniels@hemetusd.org (Please make sure all sections Minor information, Parent information, and Employer information are completed to avoid delays in processing your permit application)
- 3. Please allow a minimum of 24 hours for your work permit application to be processed. The actual work permit will be emailed to you once it has been approved (usually within 24-48 hours) All employed students under the age of 18 MUST have a current work permit on file. *You must have and maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and maintain at least a 90% attendance rate to be eligible for a work permit.
